Policy Issues	
Topic	Resolution/Action/Notes
Prairie Street Project	This individual was very much against making Prairie a major street in Sequim. Charlie and Matt answered her issues and indicated that there would be a public outreach regarding the project if/when there was a decision about how to proceed.
Manufactured home development	One individual heard there was going to be a 230-unit manufactured home development at Sequim Avenue and Old Olympic Highway/Port Williams Road. Charlie stated there was some discussion regarding a development at that location but no permit has been requested at this time.

Operational Issues	
Topic	Resolution/Action/Notes
Sunnyside and Washington crosswalk	An individual complained about drivers not yielding to pedestrians at the crosswalk. Why is there not one of those stand-up signs in the middle of the street at that crosswalk? Matt Klontz answered his question and indicated he would look at adding a sign.
Roundabouts	One person complained about people not knowing how to drive in roundabouts. They drive too fast and don't signal. People need to slow down when driving in them.
West Sequim Bay Road	One person complained about the speed people travel on this road and the lack of sidewalks. The individual feels that someone will get hurt or killed walking on the shoulder(s) of this road.
Peoples Project	Matt provided information concerning the Peoples Project.
Rally in the Alley	Will be held on Saturday, April 27.
North 7 th Avenue	One person complained about the continued speeding on North 7 th . He felt that the police should have greater enforcement efforts there. There are speed limits painted on the surface of the road and radar signs, plus very good painting of stripes on the roadside. Speed tables and police enforcement are needed. Maybe the City should consider the speed camera idea.
