### 1) Youth Human Services

- The Joe Rantz Youth Fund through Sequim Sunrise Rotary is funding homeless youth. It could be used for the host homes program. Storage is a need for kids. Perhaps a trailer at the Y or lockers at the Boys & Girls Club. Host homes is aiming for a fall launch.
- The Administration Building as a drop-in center for youth would be a great asset.
- The City discussed their human services Request for Proposals process
- Sequim School District is advocating for mental health funding at the Legislature
- The Sequim Warming Center is expanding hours/day
- We would like an update on the Youth Van provided by Serenity House

### 2) Youth Services

- Sequim School District had about 40 people at their capital project meeting this week
- The City of Sequim is going to run a Participatory Budgeting Program and would like to involve youth and the schools
- Fir Street is planned to begin construction in May
- We'll do more planning on the next Youth Summit at the next meeting
