County Commissioners,

The Childcare Group and its subcommittees (3) continue to meet and have some updated information, including a revised cost estimate for service delivery. After further detailed planning amongst the original three agencies and the full addition of Forks to the planning process, the paragraph and table below break down how we propose to meet Clallam County’s needs for childcare for ages 5-12 through the end of September. Boys & Girls Clubs (PA/Sequim) will serve as the administrative agent for the collaborative effort to help ease the burden of administration at the County level and for the partnering agencies. As a result, you would have a contract only with them for the total amount. The paragraphs and table below describe how it would be divided from there.

Boys & Girls Clubs (PA/Sequim), YMCA (PA), William Shore Pool District/SPARK’s (PA), and Concerned Citizens (Forks) are requesting CARE’s Act Funding for School-Age children’s services in the amount of \$165,000. The funding will help defray COVID-19 childcare related expenses from March – July and provide some support for anticipated operational/programmatic changes for August through September 2020.

Working in collaboration, the four agencies request that the following allocations from Clallam County be provided through Boys & Girls Clubs:

Boys & Girls Clubs (Port Angeles & Sequim)	\$40,000 for services, \$4,000 for administration
Concerned Citizens (Forks)	\$21,000
Wm. Shore Pool/SPARK’s (Port Angeles)	\$60,000
YMCA (Port Angeles)	\$40,000
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$165,000</b>

The partnership mentioned above is developing a one-page summary that we hope will be successful in gaining additional private foundation support to sustain this important effort beyond the end of September.

Agencies in the Childcare Group are also working on a grant proposal to the Department of Commerce that is separate from COVID-19 funding available to further advance childcare service delivery collaboration in Clallam County across sectors.
