In accordance with SMC 20.01.240(F), appeals of this Final Decision of the Hearing Examiner shall be made to Clallam County Superior Court within 21 calendar days of the date the decision becomes final which is 4:00pm on September 19, 2022. All appeals must conform with procedures set forth in Chapter 36.70C RCW. The cost of transcribing and preparing all records ordered certified by the court or desired by the appellant for such appeal shall be borne by the appellant.
